Motivation

Two years after the inception of AE EU, I wish to stay in the board because the ambition of the association is in keeping with my vision of agroecology and further work is to be done with a renewed board, as we have foreseen it during our founding meeting in Graux. Hopefully we'll have new candidates, likely to bring new insights and implement what is already on tracks, also expecting we'll have positive feedback from foundations likely to support our agenda. I also wish to continue maintaining links with other countries and organisations supporting the development of agroecology. I also intend contribute to some of the activities related with agroecological trajectories and paradigms, mapping of agroecologies, learning and professionalization in agroecology, co-presence with organic and other ecologically-based agricultures.

Short resumé

As an agronomist (by training) in an agroecological transition, I already have many contacts with other disciplines and stakeholders in my research activity. This facilitates the understanding of agroecology as interacting between several dimensions. I am also involved in training at various levels (especially at master level), including with on-line courses (mooc and webinars). I am currently involved in ISSAE, research projects (among them, one on the "institutionnalisations of agroecologies", IDEA funded by ANR; and one on the coordination of research in OF).
