Dear Agroecology Europe Members,

Two years ago when I first presented myself to be a board member of Agroecology Europe I have already written a long introductory letter (you can read it [here](#)), so please allow me to be much briefer now. My intentions have not changed, on the contrary, became even stronger to be an actor for the much needed Agroecological Transition. As the coordinator of the Hungarian Agroecology Network I wish to build and facilitate a stronger cooperation between different actors coming from the civil society with a special emphasis on the ones from the Central and Eastern European region as I believe we are stronger together and we have much to learn from each other.

Since my election as a Board Member in January 2020, I organized a [Regional Policy Round Table on Green Public Procurement](#), contributed to several publications such as the '[Rethinking Regenerative Food Systems](#)', or the [Mapping of Agroecology in Hungary](#) - both in English and [Hungarian](#), and the one which resulted of a 10 week long communication campaign on the [10 elements of Agroecology of FAO with Hungarian examples](#), but I also organized an online conference on [The Importance of Agroecology in Research and Education](#) with my colleagues. But the most important activity has been going on for more than a year now, which is the coordination of the Hungarian Agroecology Network, a newly forming national coalition between farmers, food producers, members of the civil society, consumers groups and academia and researchers to promote agroecology in Hungary in practice, research and education and policies.

As a board member I wish to bring in fresh other perspectives - not only the above mentioned Central Eastern European CSO ones, but as well a young female farmer one - even though that for the moment I devote much much more time to fight for food sovereignty and social justice than to my farm..

I hope you will honour me with your trust to renew my board membership so I can continue to add my part for making the Association Agroecology Europe a more inclusive organization.
