We understand agroecology jointly as a science, practice, and social movement. Our approach encompasses the whole food system from the soil to the organization of human societies. It is value-laden and based on core principles.

OUR VISION

Agroecology Europe intends to place agroecology high on the European agenda of sustainable farming and food systems.

We foster interaction and knowledge sharing to create an inclusive European community of professionals, practitioners, and societal stakeholders in agroecology.



OUR OBJECTIVES

- Foster exchange and collaboration between scientists, advisers, farmers, food producers, consumers, other stakeholders, and citizens in Europe;
